#### Dress Deposit Policy

For a female-identified student who lives in Saskatoon, she will work with volunteers of The Princess Shop at her dress appointment, and she will be required to pay a \$40.00 cash deposit fee for the dress. For a female-identified student who does not live in Saskatoon, she must arrange her own transportation to come to Saskatoon for an appointment, and she will be required to pay a \$60.00 cash deposit fee for the dress. If transportation will be an issue, please contact us as soon as possible. Deposits are due before the dress appointment and will be reimbursed in full when the dress is returned within 60 days of the graduation date. The Dress Deposit also covers the ability to borrow shoes, jewelry and other accessories available at The Princess Shop.

**Cash only. No dress will be loaned if the deposit has not been paid.**
