The Scholarship Award

Awards will be granted to one (1) qualified applicant for the 2020 Graduation Season to fully cover tuition for a full-time diploma program at SBC. ***Please note that the recipient must cover cost of books and supplies (used books may reduce cost. Responsibility of recipient to seek out used books).***

Administrative Assistant, 936 hours (9 months): tuition is \$8,006
Estimated textbooks, supplies and exam fees: \$2,650

Medical Administrative Assistant, 1120 hours (10 months): tuition is \$9,087. Estimated textbooks, supplies and exam fees: \$3,489

Executive Assistant, 1040 hours (10 months): tuition is \$8,993
Estimated textbooks, supplies and exam fees: \$3,450

Business Administration, 1040 hours (10 months): tuition is \$8,993
Estimated textbooks, supplies and exam fees: \$3,500

Accounting, 1040 hours (10 months): tuition is \$8,993
Estimated textbooks, supplies and exam fees: \$3,350

Legal Administrative Assistant, 1040 hours (10 months): tuition is \$9,087. Estimated textbooks, supplies and exam fees: \$3,350

The Application

Any Princess Graduate is eligible to apply

Applications must include:

- **Successful completion of the SBC entrance assessment
- A completed application form, which is provided with this sheet.
- A 500–word written essay or a 3–minute video essay on the following topic:
Tell us about 1) your background 2) why it’s important for you to receive this SBC scholarship and 3) what your long term goals are?

**** Applicant must call SBC at 306–244–6333 to make an appointment to complete the entrance assessment.**

In order to receive the scholarship, the applicant must agree to provide a confirmation of enrolment within the first month of starting your program or course. Courses must start within six (6) months of being selected as the recipient of the scholarship.
