



## Saskatoon Business College Award

Saskatoon Business College (SBC) is a registered career college located in Saskatoon that offers diploma programs. ### The Scholarship Award

The scholarship is open to female-identifying and 2SLGBTQ+ Saskatchewan Graduates who may not have the economic or funding options available to them to attend post-secondary education.

A scholarship will be granted to one (1) qualified applicant to fully cover the enrollment tuition for one of SBC's base programs: Accounting, Graphic Design, Administrative Assistant, or Business Administration. ***Please note that the recipient must cover the cost of the books and supplies (used books may reduce cost; it is the responsibility of the recipient to seek out used books).***

### The Application

Any Graduate who has participated in The Princess Shop's Dress Program and is interested in a program offered through SBC may apply for this award. All ages are welcome to apply.

Applications must include:

- A completed application form, that can be found on our website or emailed to you.

Once you apply, the Saskatoon Business College will reach out to schedule a meeting to discuss your educational goals.

A SBC entrance exam will be required if the applicant is applying with a GED/ABE/Mature Student. Applicants able to provide Grade 12 transcripts showing an overall average of 60% or greater will not need to complete the entrance exam.

The deadline to apply is July 1st, 2023. The recipient will be announced on July 22, 2023.

In order to receive the scholarship, the applicant must agree to provide a confirmation of enrolment within the first month of starting your program or course. Courses must start within six (6) months of being selected as the recipient of the scholarship.
